

Program and Planning Committee – February 18th, 2016

The P&P committee met in January to discuss the strategic plan. We walked through each objective of the plan and are making great strides to ensure that our goals are met for this year. The below listed objectives are what were discussed in the meeting:

- The combined state plan will be due March 1, 2016. It has been approved by the Commissioners on January 11th, 2016. The next step is to be approved by RSA before being submitted to the core partners for the combined plan.
- Objective 1.1 is currently on hold until we know more, however, VR/VS performance measure and accountabilities will be changing. VR and VS divisions will start making changes July 1, 2016.
- Objective 1-2 is currently on hold as well as ORC and DSU are awaiting regulations to be released per objective 1-1.
- Objective 1.3 has been met through the state planning process.
- Objective 1.4 has been met by ORC through the committee work and reports are submitted to ORC every quarter.
- Objective 1.5 has been met as it is ongoing by the ORC throughout all committee work and discussion at the quarterly meetings through the state plan.
- Objective 1.6 will be met as the next committee meeting will have Sandi Wright and her unit, Program Standards & Policy Development (PSPD) to discuss the comprehensive statewide needs assessment (CSNA). They are identifying unserved and underserved populations, which is a required component of the needs assessment. The CSNA is a 3 year project and the next one is 2017. DSU will be doing this internally. They will be still working with IL Center and other advocacy groups to gather information.
- Activity 1 is a work in progress as the committee will meet with Sandi Wright and the PSPD Unit on how to approach consumer satisfaction surveys.
- Activity 2 is ongoing and being met as the Field Coordinators report out to the council at the ORC quarterly meetings.
- Activity 3 is met as the website is ready and is live for public viewing.
- Activity 4 is being met as ORC does encourage updates to be sent from other disability groups and resources to the council.
- Activity 5 has been met through the state plan process.

- Activity 6 has been met as it relates to activity 3 and 4 as well as being aware of the planning within the workforce system. Utilizing Oklahoma Works, Workforce Systems meetings and conference information for review and analysis for further action items to bring to the council.
